Forest habitats were represented in 80% of Protected Areas.



Most consistent issue across most habitats was unleashed dogs.

POPULARITY OF OUTDOOR SPORTS DURING COVID





14% Decreased 6% No change

Increased 80%

80% of respondents indicated that demand and use of the protected areas has increased during Covid.

55% indicated that this correlated with an increase in irresponsible behaviours.
