Learning experience



Topic

Littering

MTB specific activities



30-60 min



Participants

- know about different types of litter
- are able to get active in litter picking



Suitable for outdoor sport instructors (and course participants)



Practical sessions



Outdoor F2F



Materials needed

Trail bandit bingo cards (see printable resource)



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Preparation

Print Trash Bandit Bingo cards and take them with you to your trails.

Activity instruction

Hand the cards out to the kids and let them do a litter clean up. If they found each item of litter displaced on the bingo card, then you have a winner.

Reflection and discussion

Combine with theoretical / classroom lessons about what litter is, how it pollutes our environment, how long it takes to decompose and how to prevent littering and no more use of single use plastics.



Potential Variations

Good to combine with "Breakdown game" to learn more about rotting times of different types of litter.
