Learning experience







10-30 min.

Nature connectedness and environmental engagement flora, fauna



Participants

- have a higher nature awareness
- are able to focus their attention on the surrounding nature
- understand the rich biodiversity of nature and different interpretations of it



Suitable for outdoor sport instructors (and course participants)



Practical sessions

Materials needed

Special bingo grid (see appendix)

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Preparation

Hand out a bingo grid per participant.

Activity instruction

See who can be the first to find four items in a row, column, or corner to corner! Although the first person that achieves to find four items in a row has to shout Bingo and is the winner, everybody carries on until the educator ends the game.

Reflection and discussion

After the main activity, use the observations for a short reflection.

What plants, animal traces, sounds etc. did you observe? Etc.



Potential variation

The group could be asked to fill in the whole card.

- Variations for the content of the cards are manifold. The SEE Bingo card is also available for sustainability.
- Instead of using a Bingo grid you can also use a Scoring card or Booklet for doing a nature hunt (See examples provided)


